We have been made aware of an issue relating to the Pearson BTEC National Applied Science Student Book 1 ISBN 9781292134093. On page 185 of this textbook, under the Case Study section referring to a Trainee science technician, Question 1 instructs learners to refer to Hazard Cards in order to answer the Check your knowledge question. This is misleading. We would advise that learners do not have access to Hazard Cards, but instead we recommend that learners should be directed to use Student Safety Sheets. This is in line with guidance from CLEAPPS.
