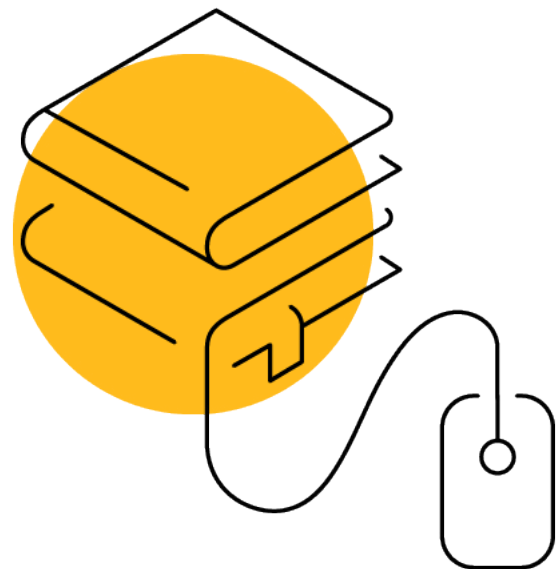

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What actually is the **Mocks Service**?

The Mocks Service provides schools and colleges with Pearson Edexcel GCSE and A level exam papers for use in mock exams.

The service is available on an on-demand basis from September to the end of July. We have an extensive paper-based service and also offer an onscreen service across some subjects.

There are two service options available:

- **The Mocks Marking Service** 
- **The Mocks Moderation Service** 

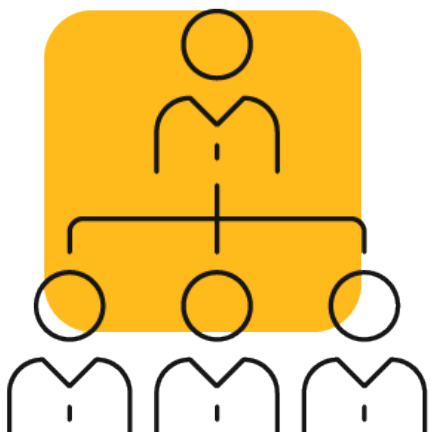
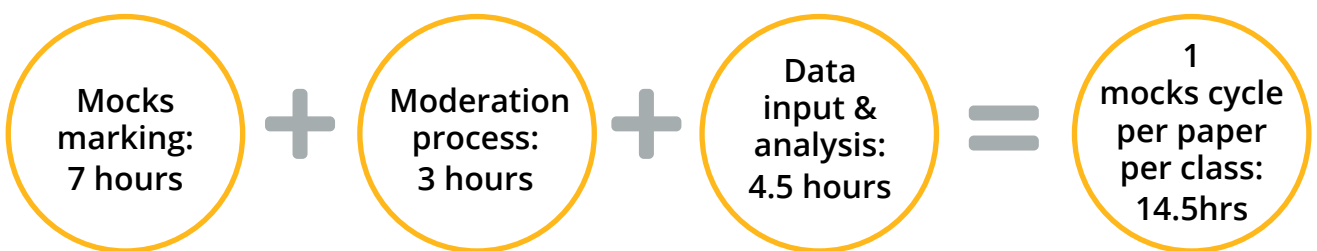


The Mocks Marking Service

- The **Mocks Marking Service** provides schools and colleges with Pearson Edexcel GCSE and A level papers for use in your mock exams, that are then marked by Pearson examiners with results uploaded to **ResultsPlus** for item level analysis.
- For paper-based mocks, papers are delivered to schools and colleges within 3 weeks of submitting student entries via the booking portal.
- From receipt of completed mock exams, results will be uploaded to ResultsPlus within 21 days for paper-based and 14 days for onscreen.
- With our flexible service, your students can sit mock exams at a time that suits you.

On average a teacher spends 15 minutes marking a Mocks paper.

This means a class of 28 students can take up to 14.5 hours to mark if you take into account moderation and analysis of papers.

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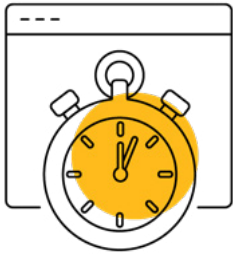

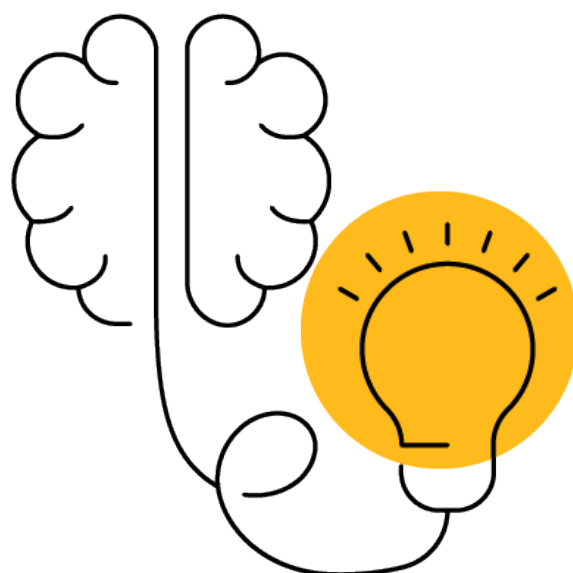
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The Mocks Moderation Service

- The new **Moderation Service** will allow you to provide your students with exam level mocks whilst supporting your marking skills. By sending in a sample of your exam papers our moderators can provide commentaries and reports to help you develop your marking skills.
- Send us a sample of around 15% of their own marked papers to be reviewed by our expert moderators.
- Our examiners will moderate your papers and provide you with PDF copies of scripts with commentaries along with a moderation report.

How does the Moderation service help?

- Gain an understanding of the mark scheme and provide reassurance that marking is aligned with the Pearson Edexcel standard
- Help ensure your teams' marking is consistent
- Provides confidence in your teams' judgement
- Identify areas that need improvement

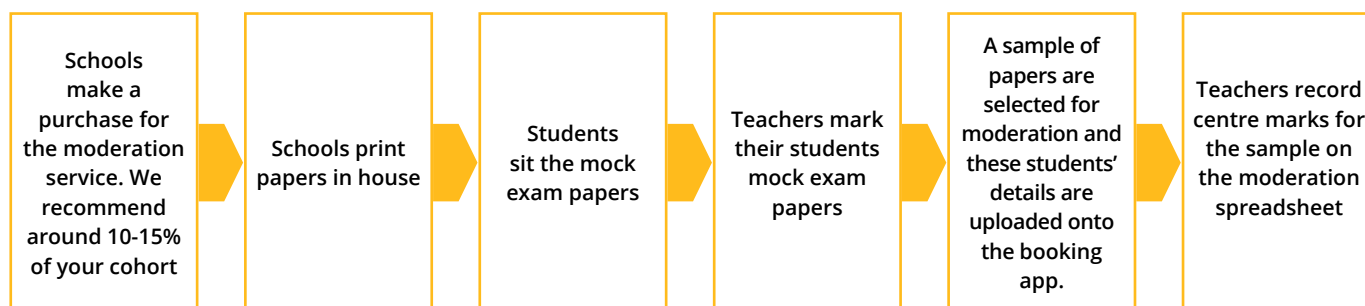


What do you receive?

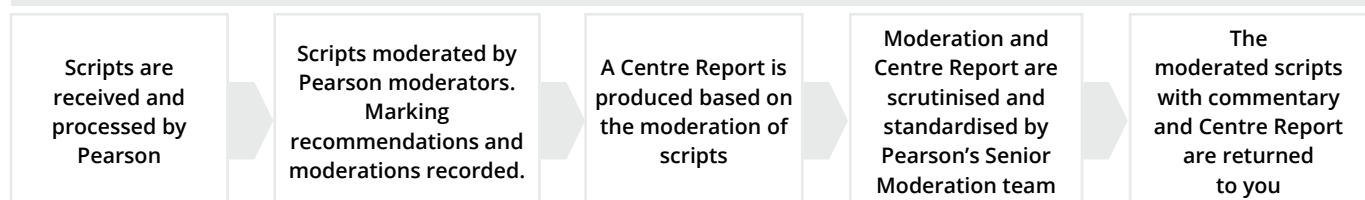

Returning Moderated Mocks to schools

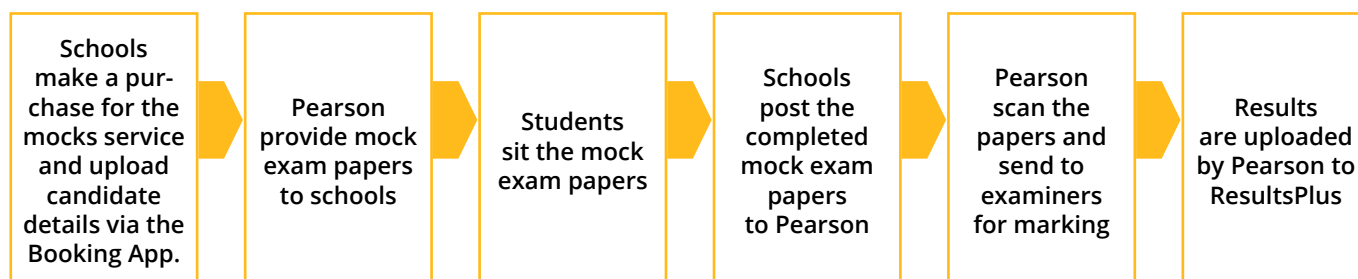

- We'll aim to complete marking and upload your students' marks to **ResultsPlus** within the timeframes below:
 - **Paper-based** – within 21 days of receiving the completed scripts back.
 - **Onscreen** – within 14 days of assessments being submitted onscreen.

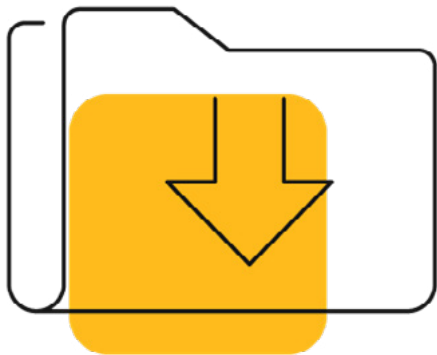

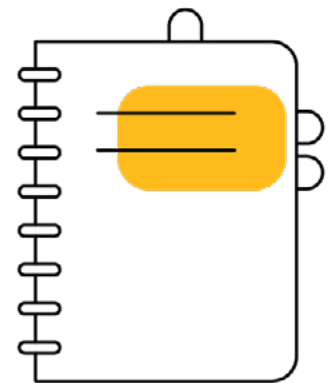

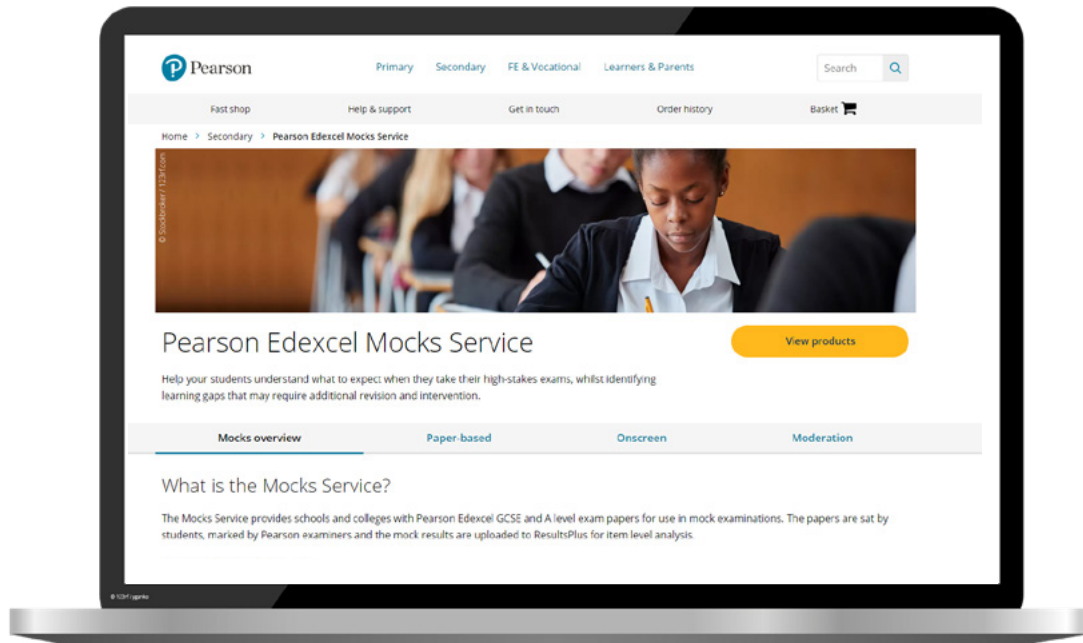
